- The route is self-guided and includes stations with small tasks, friendly helpers, and Viennese surprises.
- All groups will reunite for a special surprise at Vienna's most iconic location –
 Stephansplatz. Let's just say: it'll be worth staying until the end.
- Dinner and dessert are included no need to bring snacks, but please bring your refillable water bottle! Vienna has some of the world's best drinking water straight from the Alps and available for free at fountains throughout the city. Stay hydrated and sustainable!
